

POLICY ON TUTION REFUNDS

REVIEW REQUIREMENTS: Every two (2) years

PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR POLICY: Senior Education Administrator

POLICY PURPOSE

The Policy on Refunds establishes the standards set by Seabird College for refunds of payments to students and is in accordance with the requirements of the Private Training Regulation. It is the policy of the College to formalize the regulations on the approval and disbursement of refunds on fees charged by the College, as outlined below.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all individuals applying for admission to the College, all enrolled students, all individuals employed by the College, and any other individuals acting as representatives or holding a titular position of the College.

POLICY

A. REGULATIONS FOR TUITION REFUNDS

When a tuition refund is due, Seabird College will provide it to the student within thirty (30) days of:

- i. Receiving notice of withdrawal from a student
- ii. Receiving a copy of the refusal of a study permit
- iii. Providing a student with a notice of dismissal
- iv. Receiving an order from the Registrar to issue a refund because a student was admitted in an approved program without meeting the admission requirements
- v. The program end date included in the enrolment contract, if Seabird College did not provide a work experience to a student within thirty (30) days of the end date
- vi. The date on which the first 30% of the program would have been completed, if the student did not attend the first 30% of the program

Seabird College will refund fees charged for textbooks or other course materials, including equipment and uniforms if the student does not receive these course materials and any of the following apply:

- The student provides a notice of withdrawal to Seabird College or Seabird College provides notice of dismissal to the student
- ii. The student does not attend any of the first 30% of the hours of the instruction of the program.

Fees and tuition refund for programs that do not require approval	Refund due	
Programs that do not require approval - programs that have tuition of \$4,000 or more:		
 The student does not attend the program, and The institution receives from the student a notice of withdrawal or a copy of refusal of a study permit no later than 30 days after the later of: a) the start date of the program in the most recent Letter of Acceptance b) the start date of the program in the enrolment contract. 	100% tuition and all related fees, other than application fees. Seabird College must pay the student within thirty (30) days of receiving a notice of withdrawal or a copy of refusal of a study permit, as applicable.
